Passing the DDGEO title

Month after Month during our normal times of Stated and Special Communications, we all sign in as members of our Lodge. You may have noticed at the top of your Sign- In Book, there is a blank to fill in as to the type of meeting, Lodge Name, and then we come to the date. There are two spaces. One is the calendar year as is



commonly used and the one that we are all used to. I am writing this article on May 6, 2020. However, if I were using the Masonic Dating System Anno Lucis, meaning in the Year of Light, the date would be written May 6, 6020 AL. Why is this, well put simply 4000 BC was adopted in the 18th Century as a simplification of the Anno Mundi era dating system used in the Hebrew calendar which really refers to the year of creation.

We as Mason's have adopted this dating system as the receiving of Light is an important symbol to us. We know from the book of Genesis that God brought Light to the World and created the day and night. Since this dating system refers directly to the creation of the world, and as Light is central to our Degrees, we have the Anno Lucis dating system.

Finally, as we come to the close of this Masonic Calendar year, I wanted to extend my personal thanks and appreciation to the Brethren of Unity Lodge for allowing me to provide an educational piece for your Trestle Board but more importantly for welcoming me as a part of your Lodge. Whether it be attendance at a Master's Class, and educational topic and discussion as a part of your Stated or just sharing a meal at before your Stated or the District Dine-Around, it has truly been a wonderful two years.

As you may have heard, I will be installed on May 16th as the Grand Education for New Hampshire. - 3. If ANY member of your Lodge or any other body that has been in your building tests positive for COVID-19, please inform the Grand Lodge Office immediately.
- 4. If you have any questions please don't hesitate to contact me. If I don't know the answer I will find out for you.

P.S. The Grand Master has offered up one more recommendation to add to his list.

1. When saluting the flag, do it in place to avoid having the Marshal carry the flag and pass in close proximity to other Brethren.

Hopefully we will be able to move to Stage 2 relatively soon.



Grand Lecturer Inspection Guidelines, June 15, 2020

- Rehearsals may restart on July 1, 2020.
- Degree inspections can be scheduled to occur on or after August 1, 2020.
- All inspections will not include a candidate, active or exemplar, until further notice. Officers will
 be asked to simulate the presence of a candidate to the best of their ability.
- All officers will wear masks, maintain social distancing of 6 feet, and will avoid all direct physical
 interaction despite the typical requirements of the degree (no grips, etc.). Officers will strictly
 follow the guidelines laid out by the Grand Master on June 10, 2020. <u>There should be no person-</u>
 to-person contact.
- If there is something that an officer would typically do to direct or instruct the candidate during the degree, that officer will narrate the process and act it out as best as he can. For example, the Senior Deacon's handling of the candidate in preparation for the obligation.
- When the Grand Master restarts Degree performances for our candidates, inspections will subsequently follow those revised guidelines.
- For the 2nd Section of the Master Mason Degree, no more than two "craftsman" (the First Craftsman and one other) will be allowed.
- For the portion of 2nd Section of the Master Mason Degree just prior to and containing the "raising" of the Candidate (page 99, line 25 and beyond), only the Master, Chaplain, Senior Warden and Marshal will participate.
